The unusual brass accompaniment to Vivaldi's Gloria was interesting and imaginative, but at times the brass was a little 'heavy' when compared to the original setting for string orchestra.

Altogether the Sheldon Singers presented a thoroughly enjoyable evening and has set us up for the countdown to Christmas!'
